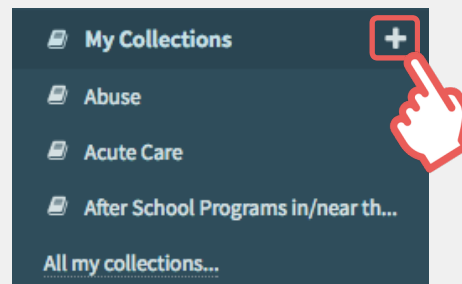

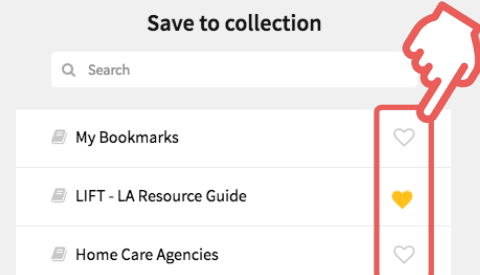
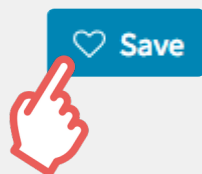
1 Create a collection

In the left-hand sidebar, use the “+” button next to “My Collections” to get started with a new collection. For more tips on creating collections, please see page 2 of this handout.



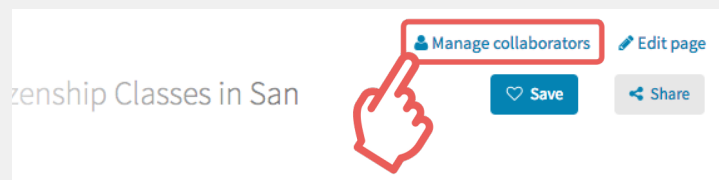
2 Add resources

Collaborate with your team by inviting your colleagues to view, edit or manage your collections.



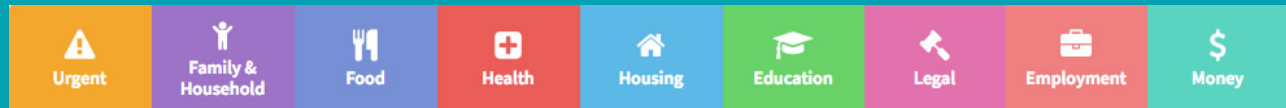

Tips for creating a collection on www.1degree.org :

A. Title

You can create collections by types of service or communities served. For example, create a collection of “Resources for Spanish-speaking Pregnant Women.” The title helps your clients and your team easily understand the content of the collection.

C. Author

Add an author and manage who can view the collection. You can set yourself, the name of your organization, or some other name to be the author. This will appear on the collections page.

B. Location

Specify an address, city, neighborhood, or Zip code, as it relates to this collection. For example, you might be creating a collection of food resources for the entire Los Angeles area or just a specific neighborhood within Los Angeles.
